



Attention: All captain and players

### **Teams**

- Team is 6 players a side and they can make 2 changes at half time.
- Teams can have as many registered players as they like but can only make 2 changes and only at half time. Max 8 player per night.
- 4 players is the minimum to take the court and to start the game. The clock will be started after waiting a few minutes for a late team to show up or for enough players to start the game. Once the clock is started they have 4 minutes to get 4 players on the court or they forfeit.

### **Registration**

- All players have 4 weeks to register from the start of the competition
- Registration is \$7 per player each competition
- Your team cannot play an unregistered player not even just to fill a full team
- Unregistered players cannot take the court. Game points will be lost
- Registration for new players ends 4 weeks prior to the semis with no exceptions

### **Personal Injury cover**

- Registration does not cover personal injury cover. If you would like any further information on having this coverage please call Ian Hewitt and Association on 4731 5335

### **Bond**

- Team Bond is \$110 per team. New teams have 4 weeks from the start of the competition to pay the bond.
- Upon a forfeit, bond is lost and must be replaced within 2 weeks to remain in the competition.
- If your team must forfeit you must call in advance or before 4pm on the day to notify us. This way your bond will not be affected.
- If your team does not call before 4pm, does not have enough players to start the game or does not show up your bond will be lost.
- If your team does not forfeit during the competition your bond will be returned or transferred to the next competition.

### **Game Fee**

- \$55 per team must be paid on the night.
- Captain collect the money from the players and pays for the team

### **Uniforms**

- All the teams must be in uniform or same colour shirts each game.

### **Signing on**

- All players must sign on before the game and the captain needs to check score and sign at the end of the game. Please remind all players to sign.

**Referees**

- You may not always agree with the referees decision, but the referees decision is final. The captain can approach the ref at half time or full time only, in a respectful manner with any questions or queries.

**Red cards**

- Any player sent from the court have an automatic 2 week suspension. No exceptions.

**All players**

- Any offensive language, behavior or fighting will not be tolerated.
- Any payer under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be able to play and will be suspended from the team and centre.
- Any unregistered persons found signing on as another person will result in loss of points for that team and may result in them being unable to play with the team in the future.

**Protective gear**

- Protective equipment is a good idea (shin pads, mouth guards, goalie gloves etc) but is not compulsory and can be worn by any player wishing to do so.

**Reserves and spectators**

- There is to be no comment or sledging from any player or spectator on the sideline to any player, team and especially the referee.

**Semi finals and grand finals**

- At the end of the competition the top 8 teams will go through the semi finals. The first 4 teams at the end of the semis will go to A grade and the next 4 go to B grade. The winning teams through each grade will go through to the grand final.
